



PATRON PROTOCOL

1. When you arrive at the entry checkpoints (via the driveway at 2838 Butler Road), please don your facemask and present your parking credentials.
2. After entry, patrons will proceed to their assigned parking spaces with assistance from the parking crew. Parking spaces will be spaced to accommodate social distancing. No parking spaces will be reserved, except for in the preassigned Railside parking area.
3. **FACEMASKS MUST BE WORN AT ALL TIMES** while on the race grounds, except when nearby your vehicle or in a reserved sponsor area, eating and drinking.

WE ASK FOR YOUR COMPLETE AND TOTAL COOPERATION IN ORDER FOR THIS DAY TO RUN SMOOTHLY, ENSURING A HEALTHY, SAFE, AND ENJOYABLE EVENT FOR ALL.

NOTE: Please be advised that the Grand National Steeplechase Association will not provide any food or drink for consumption. There will be limited trash receptacles and/or collection at the event. Patrons must bring any and all provisions with them to and from the property. For the health and safety of our competitors and community, no ATVs / buses / campers / trucks, balloons, pop-up tents, grills / open flames, or drones will be allowed. Thank you.
