



TRAINER PROTOCOL

1. When you arrive at the entry checkpoint (via the driveway at 2605 Butler Road), please don your facemask and present your entry / parking credentials.
2. All Trainers will park in the designated Assembly Area Parking.
3. Trainers may circulate between their vehicle / trailer in the Assembly Area Parking, the stabling / testing area in the Assembly Area, the Paddock, and the racecourse for viewing the races.
4. **FACEMASKS MUST BE WORN AT ALL TIMES** while on the race grounds, except when eating and drinking.
5. There will be no admittance to the Stewards Stand.

PLEASE REMEMBER: All Trainers running horses at the Grand National must submit the Trainer's Grooms List to the NSA Office by 5:00 PM, Wednesday, April 14th in order for their Grooms to enter the property on race day. All trainers are responsible for sharing the *Groom's Protocol* with their grooms and assuring their understanding of and readiness to comply.

NOTE: Please be advised that the Grand National Steeplechase Association will not provide any drinks, snacks, and/or ice for personal consumption. There will be limited trash receptacles and/or collection at the event. Everyone must bring any and all provisions with them to the property. Thank you.
